**FAMILIES WITH 2 OR MORE STUDENTS REGISTERED:** The second sibling discount is \$300 off the yearly tuition. The discount is deducted from the second child's April, 2011 payment.

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** The **non-refundable** Registration Fee is due upon enrollment. **The first tuition payment is due by May 5, 2010. This payment is not refundable after June 1, 2010.** Monthly tuition payments are due **on or before the fifth** day of each month from August 2010 through April 2011. A \$5.00 late fee is charged after the fifteenth of the month.

**PAYMENT PLANS:** You may choose the 10 month payment plan: May, 2010 and August, 2010 to April, 2011. Call the school office to learn more about the 12 month payment plan. Tuition must be paid in full by April 5, 2011.

**PREPAID DISCOUNT:** You receive a discount of 5% off tuition if it is paid in full by August 23, 2010. The May, 2010 payment must be made and will be subtracted from the total. Call the office for details.

**ADMISSION EVALUATION:** An ability evaluation and an achievement evaluation, such as the (K-BIT), are given to all students entering the first grade and to students new to the school entering first through sixth grades. A Kindergarten readiness evaluation is given to students entering Kindergarten. The fee for any required evaluation is included in the non-refundable *Application and/or Registration/Supply Fee*.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is available for students enrolled in Kindergarten-Grade 6 whose families qualify based on financial need. Information and applications are available in the school office.

**OTHER PROGRAMS AND FEES:** Information is issued at a later date regarding the following:

- Hot lunch program
- After Care Programs
- Lunch drink – milk program (paid by the semester or year)
- Birthday books donated to the library (purchased through the library)
- Fundraisers such as T-shirts, Annual Giving Campaign, Annual Auction, and Pumpkin Patch
- Field trip fees
- Class supply list and other supplies needed throughout the school year

**WAITING LIST:** When a class is filled to maximum capacity, a numbered waiting list is created. When the list increases for a certain class, an additional class of the same grade will be opened.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND A SUMMARY OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:** Parents must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate, immunization record, previous school records, and documents of custody arrangements, if applicable.
